


Jacquart Events LLC (Producer), Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor), Disc Golf Pro Tour (Media Sponsor), Wildhorse Golf Course (Host), and Team Las Vegas Challenge (Volunteers), in partnership with the many other sponsors (see pages **40** & **42** for details) are honored to present the 22ND Annual Las Vegas Challenge (LVC) disc golf tournament! New for 2021, the MPO & FPO divisions will be participating in the DGPT Elite Series.

The 2021 format will mimic that used since 2016 (the year the LVC was moved form Sunset Park), with each of the \approx 570 participants playing all three temporary courses at least once, and only the top 40% of each division playing a fourth round in the Sunday finals. Should the LVC return to the DGPT Elite Series in 2022, it is anticipated that participants will only be playing one or two of the three courses...so there may be a significant change in the venue next year.

The 135-acre Wildhorse property offers ample room for three premier course designs (each with their own "flare"); a large warm up area; a grand vendor tent; an indoor media, check-in, and VIP center; ample room for a player warm-up area (which also hosts the Saturday night Player's Party); and many extra-curricular activities (nine-hole mini golf, putting challenge, etc.). 2021 PDGA PRO MAJORS, ELITE SERIES



The Disc Golf Pro Tour (DGPT) 2021 Elite Series comprises 12 of the highest caliber events in the sport, and includes:

Las Vegas Challenge • February 25th – 28th Waco Annual Charity Open • March 12th – 14th Jonesboro Open • April 16th – 18th San Francisco Open • May 14th -16th Portland Open • June 4th – 6th Discraft's Great Lakes Open • July 23rd – 25th The Preserve Championship • July 30th – August 1st Discraft's Ledgestone Insurance Open • August 5th – 8th Idlewild Open • August 13th – 15th MVP Open • September 3rd – 5th Green Mountain Championship • September 9th – 12th Disc Golf Pro Tour Championship • October 14th – 17th

The DGPT is happy to welcome the Las Vegas Challenge as the 2021 season's opening event. Much of the remaining 2020 schedule remains familiar, in part due to the effect that the pandemic had on the slate 2020 events starting at Waco, TX in March when the DGPT suspended operations.

The 2021 schedule offers a hopeful return to the west coast with the San Francisco Open and Portland Open while keeping one new event from 2020 on the schedule, The Preserve Championship in Minnesota. The DGPT also very much wanted to return to Emporia for a second Dynamic Discs Open, however, the schedule is extremely tight and simply offers few opportunities for additional Elite Series. That said, we look forward to being at the GBO in late April. We plan to be back for the DDO in years to come.

The PDGA's National Tour will take place alongside DGPT Elite Series as follows:


Texas State Championships • March 26th – 28th Glass Blown Open • April 28th – May 1st Master's Cup • May 28th – 30th Beaver State Fling • June 11th – 13th Delaware Disc Golf Challenge • August 27th – 29th Music City Open • September 24th – 26th

In all, professional disc golf will have 18 Elite Series events in 2021 plus three majors (Pro Worlds, European Open, and USDGC/USWDGC). A slate of 20 events plus the Tour Championship will create a full schedule for professionals and fans alike to follow.

The DGPT gains a distinct Elite Series Tier designation with the PDGA and it's National Tour. The designation comes in recognition of the Tour as a series of events above the A-Tier level. Events on the DGPT have strict competition, added cash, media requirements, and spectator conditions, which have helped the professional game grow and have led to this designation. The DGPT is pleased to work more closely with the PDGA in 2021, and in the subsequent years to come.







Disc golf is typically played without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the player to show sportsmanship, integrity, consideration for other players, and to abide by the Rules of Play. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.

Make the call. Accept the call.

It's not personal; it's the rules. That is the spirit of the game of disc golf.



- **806.05.B**: A disc is in a hazard if its position is clearly and completely surrounded by the hazard or by a combination of the hazard and an out-of-bounds area.
 - **811.C:** If a misplay is discovered after the scorecard has been turned in, the player receives two the penalty throws applicable to the misplay.

2021 Competition Updates

- **1.05.G:** The Tournament Director must provide two scorecards to each group, to be kept independently of one another. These scorecards may be of the same medium or of different media. The two scorecards must be reconciled by the group and submitted by whichever method the Tournament Director has designated as the official scoring method for the tournament.
- **1.08.C:** If additional players below the payout line made the cut due to ties, only those players remaining at least tied for a payout position would get paid.
- **1.13.A:** Any child younger than 13 years of age who is accompanying any player group and is not a caddie must be supervised by an adult who is not part of that player group and not a caddie.

2020 Disciplinary Process

There is a classification system for different offenses and the definition of standard penalty ranges for those offenses. The classes are:


Class A - Most serious, and generally involve actual harm to other players. Includes physical battery, sexual assault, credible threats of imminent harm to another player, stalking, and intimidation. Class A offenses carry a <u>standard 24-month suspension</u> followed by 12 months of probation but can include a permanent ban.

Class B - Generally involve intentional subversion of the Rules of Play, dishonesty, or cheating. Includes purposeful misuse or misinterpretation of the Rules of Play and/or Competition Manual to gain a competitive advantage, purposefully misreporting scores of any player, impersonating another PDGA member, or refusing to provide the name associated with the player's PDGA membership and/or PDGA number. Class B offenses carry a standard 12-month suspension followed by 12 months of probation but can include a permanent ban.

Class C - Generally involve instances where intent is difficult to prove, but there is an articulable and provable pattern of misbehavior. Includes harassment without physical threat (such as discrimination; unwanted sexual advances; or racist, sexist, or prejudiced language or epithets), repeated failure to adhere to the Rules of Play without proof of intent to cheat, and habitual violations of courtesy rules. Class C offenses carry a <u>standard 6-month suspension followed by 3 months of probation</u> but can include a 12-month suspension with 6 months of probation.

Class D - Generally involve the impermissible use of alcohol or drugs, including instances arising under Competition Manual 3.01.A and 3.08.G (such as a tournament staff member who is intoxicated and unable to discharge their duties). Class D offenses carry a <u>standard 6 months of probation</u> but can include a 6-month suspension with 3 months of probation.

Class E - Administrative in nature and deal with nonpayment of required event or player fees, violations of the Sanctioning Agreement regarding member and/or player data, or similar infractions. Class E offenses carry a standard penalty of an openended suspension until the required fees are paid, followed by an additional month of suspension, but can include an additional 6 months of suspension.



2019 Minor Rule Changes

- **802.02.D**: If a throw does not change a player's lie (for example, missing the island on an island hole), they immediately throw again instead of waiting for others to throw.
- **802.05.C:** A drop zone may either be marked and played in the same manner as a teeing area, or in the same manner as a marked lie.
 - 802.07: There is no longer a re-throw after a stance violation. The throw counts.
- **802.07.C:** There is no longer a warning for the first stance violation.
- **803.01.B(1):** A player may move casual obstacles that are partially or completely on the lie or in the stance area, regardless of whether they extend in front of or behind the lie.
 - **803.02.A:** The five-meter limit on casual relief has been removed. You may go back along the line of play to the first available lie, however far that is.
 - **803.02.E:** A player may take free optional relief (back along the line of play) when placing the lie after taking a penalty for OB.
- **806.02.D(3):** You are guaranteed a lie up to one meter from all OB (handles OB lines that create a corner).
 - **809.03.A:** Practice throw has been redefined. A throw that travels less than 5 meters in the air to return a disc to a player or your bag is not a practice throw.
 - **809.03.B:** A player receives one penalty throw for making a practice throw; the throw itself is disregarded.
 - **810:** The consensual interference rule (formerly 804.03.G) has been removed.
 - **810.F:** Accidentally interfering with your own throw (for example, if your putt rolls back and hits you or your bag) incurs a one-throw penalty. As before, intentional interference with your own (or anyone else's) throw incurs a two-throw penalty.
 - **810.H:** You can move a disc that has landed on or behind your lie.
 - **811.F(5):** A player who is not present to play a hole gets par plus four.
 - **811.F(9):** A player who starts on the wrong hole and/or in the wrong group receives a two-throw penalty.








2019 Player Misconduct

- **3.03.A:** All players must adhere to a professional standard of sporting ethics, courtesy, and integrity while participating in a PDGA-sanctioned event and when commenting to the media. Conduct that violates this standard is subject to courtesy violations called by players (see Rule 812, Courtesy), penalties issued by the TD, and any further disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the PDGA.
- **3.03.B:** If a player violates the above standard, the TD may opt, in their sole discretion, to issue a tournament warning for a first offense (except as specified in subsection C, below). Otherwise, the TD will immediately disqualify the player. Actions that violate this standard include, but are not limited to:
 - 1. Repeated and overt use of abusive or profane language.
 - 2. Throwing items in anger (other than discs in play).
 - 3. Overt rudeness or threatening behavior to anyone present.
 - 4. Willful and overt destruction, abuse, or vandalism of property, including animal and plant life (see also Rule 803.03, Damaging the Course).
 - Public display or use of alcohol, even where otherwise lawful or permitted, from the two-minute warning until the player's scorecard is submitted <u>at an</u> <u>event sanctioned at C-Tier level or below</u> (see 3.03.C.4 for penalties at events sanctioned <u>at B-Tier or above</u>).
 - 6. Excessive use of alcohol or public intoxication at the tournament site.
 - Overt failure or refusal to enforce the rules of disc golf during competition (see 801.02.B, Enforcement).
 - 8. Obstruction of, or failure or refusal to cooperate with, any investigation by an official into the player's conduct or the conduct of another player.
 - 9. Deliberately seeking to manipulate one's player rating through intentional misplay or withdrawal (see 811.E, Misplay).
 - 10. Activities not listed here or in 3.03.C, which are in violation of federal, state or local laws, park regulations or course rules.
- **3.03.C:** The following actions also violate the above standard. Players who commit one or more of these violations will not receive a warning, and will be immediately disqualified by the TD:
 - 1. Cheating: a willful attempt to circumvent the rules of play.
 - 2. Physical attacks upon anyone present.
 - 3. Public display or use of illegal or prohibited substances in violation of any applicable law (federal, state, local, et al) from the two-minute warning to the time the player's scorecard is submitted.
 - 4. Public display or use of alcohol at PDGA events sanctioned at B-Tier or higher, or of marijuana at PDGA events sanctioned at any Tier level, even where otherwise lawful or permitted, from the two-minute warning to the time the player's scorecard is submitted.








General – Contact General Tournament Director, Jeff Jacquart, at **702-249-0387** for any problems or questions. When in doubt, use the provisional rule (809.02).

Cart Paths - The cart path is defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the concrete edge of the cart path (including raised edging) meet, unless marked by rope. All other improvements (see examples below) adjacent to the cart path are not part of the cart path. The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on dirt or grass growing over a cart path edge is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)



Casual Water - Unless marked as O.B., play casual water as a Casual Area (806.03). Lie may be relocated to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief, without penalty.



Course Availability - Courses are closed after Wednesday. Players caught playing a closed course are in violation of Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Facility main gate is locked from sundown to sunrise.

Discs Retrieval (from Back Yards & Water Areas) - Entering into private yards or wading into water to retrieve a disc will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director and potential criminal/trespassing charges by the City of Henderson Police Department.

Dress Code (applies to All Divisions) - All players are expected to dress appropriately and to maintain a clean and well-groomed appearance at all event sites and associated functions. All players must wear shoes and a well-tailored shirt with a collar and sleeves covering upper chest area and upper arm. Crew neck or v-neck shirts made of high-performance or high-tech materials are permitted. Shirts that hang down lower than the bottom hemline on the player's shorts shall be tucked in. Women may wear sleeveless shirts with collars or a well-tailored one-piece tennis dress. (Also see Competition Manual, 3.04(D).)

Green - Defined as the area within the first grass cut around a ball golf hole.

Island Holes - Disc must <u>come to rest</u> on marked islands (Course Innova, Hole 6, and Course Infinite Discs, Holes 6 and 18). If island missed, <u>as approved by the PDGA</u>, take one-stroke penalty and next shot from the designated drop zone(s). (Note that Holes 4 and 7 on Course Innova play like large island since all out-of-bounds shots from the tee pad go directly to a drop zone.)

Media Rights - Jacquart Events LLC (Producer), Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor), Disc Golf Pro Tour (Media Sponsor) and event partners owns all media rights to the LVC. Any type of professional media equipment is <u>prohibited</u> without approval from the Producer or Title Sponsor. Sharing LVC images, videos, and stories on <u>personal</u> social media outlets via non-professional equipment such as cell



phones are welcomed, as long as such personal posts are in no way monetized or promote a brand, business, product, or service. Spectators with cell phones or other non-professional portable devices are not considered media and are not granted media access. Approved media will be supplied credentials to be worn at all times while at the facility. (Also see Page 32.)

Sand Traps - Sand traps are hazards (8.06.05). Take one-stroke penalty and play it where it lies (lie is not relocated). No relief provided from sand traps. The sand trap is defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the sand meet (unless marked by rope, then rope). The hazard line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The hazard line is part of the hazard area. (A disc landing on grass growing over a sand trap is in the hazard when 100% of the disc is on the hazard-side of the vertical plane.)



Selling of Merchandise - Permission is <u>not</u> granted to sell merchandise on Wildhorse property without consent of the Tournament Director. Such activities will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Smoking Areas - There are designated smoking areas for the facility (parking lot and outside balconies) and on each course and within the practice area (within 30 feet of a restroom). Pace of play rules still apply. Any open and visual possession of any product banned under the smoking policy will be treated as a courtesy violation, and violators will be asked to put away the product until after the round has concluded.

Teeing Areas - The teeing area is defined by the area bounded by the edges of the provided tee pad (the artificial turf). When in use, Teeing Areas are in-bounds.

Two Meter Rule - Not in effect for all courses, all holes.

Water Areas - Water areas are defined as the point where the water and the roots of the grass meet (unless marked by rope). The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-anddown plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on grass growing over water is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)



Zero Tolerance - Any inappropriate activities will be dealt with immediately.





Jacquart Events LLC (Producer), Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor), Disc Golf Pro Tour (Media Sponsor) and event partners owns all media rights to the LVC. All <u>promotional</u> <u>& commercial</u> media for print, radio, television, internet, and/or video publication must be approved. Promotional & commercial media includes <u>any</u> use of LVC material monetized or which promotes a brand, business, product, or service. Approved media will be supplied credentials to be worn at all times while at the facility. **Spectators and competitors with cell phones are not considered media and are not granted media access.**

Spectators and competitors using cell phones to share LVC images, videos, and stories on **personal** social media outlets via cell phones is welcomed, as long as such personal posts are in **no way monetized or promote** a brand, business, product, or service. Professional photography and video equipment is not allowed on site without media credentials, including but not limited to DSLRs and camcorders.

Wildhorse has been reserved for a private function. Public access is not guaranteed. All spectators shall behave appropriately. Unless otherwise provided, spectators may not play on any LVC courses. The 9-hole mini course and other extra-curricular activities may be played by all attendees.

All spec<mark>tators</mark>, competitors, and approved media shall abide by the following:


- Cell phones must remain silent at all times while on the facility.
- Do not approach competitors within 30 minutes of their tee time nor at any point during their round. This applies to Starter's Tent area, transition between holes, and while waiting to tee or play.
- Remain at least 20 meters (66 feet) from competitors, all DISCatcher targets in play, and the greens.
- Make every effort to maintain positions on the course that do not interfere with competitors or tournament play. Competitors and/or LVC staff may request you to reposition at their discretion.
- Remain completely still when in close proximity to any competitor who is in the process of lining up or executing a throw.
- Avoid being in direct sightline of players. This may sometimes be unavoidable, particularly around the putting area. Competitors and/or LVC staff may ask you to move.
- Make every effort not to block a shot already set by a member of the media. Approved Media: Both still and video media share priority and are expected to demonstrate professional courtesy.
- Approved Media: Position yourself so that camera shutters cannot be heard by competitors during the throwing motion, or begin shooting once the disc has left the competitor's hand.
- · Violations of any of these rules are grounds for immediate removal from the facility.

**Boy Scouts** - No longer participating with the LVC, over the years the Boy Scouts received around \$6,000 in goods and cash to support their activities.

**Crappy Christmas (NOTI)** – Over \$1,800 was raised through various auction sales (thank you Keith Osborne) to help pay for medical costs for a young man hospitalized twice now for some mystery heart condition...and the last stay was over Christmas.

**Disc Golf in Schools** - Over \$10,000 in merchandise has been donated to our Disc Golf in Schools effort via the LVC...\$1,400 from the 2020 event alone (Vegas Verdes Elementary School received 2 baskets and 200 gently-used discs)!

**In Memory of...** - Dan Pastore, owner and founder of ABC Discs, passed away last year...and \$250 was donated to his GoFundMe page.

**Kids (& Other Newbies) Galore** - So far, \$3,000 in discs via the Innova Support Program, and some cash, has been given to kids & other newbies learning disc golf or to support a school sports program! The 2020 LVC was responsible for almost \$1,500 of this support! We'd like to thank Vince Gardner, Donn Blake, the LVDGC, the Sin City Sisters, and the Vets Disc Golf Club for handing out these discs.

**LLS Fighters** - Started in late 2018, \$10 of each LLS / "The Ricker" Ribbon stamped disc (only 100 stamped so far) goes to someone fighting LLS. In 2019, \$1,000 was donated to a young adult fighting leukemia. Check out Isabella's story at www.facebook.com/Bellas-Battle-2045364122168898.





**LLS & Team Carson** - Last year, the LVC teamed up with the Arreola Family and their LLS cause...and \$3,000 was donated to LLS (in the name of Team Carson)! \$10 of each LLS / Team Carson stamped disc (up to 200 stamped so far) is donated to LLS, and all income from the Distance and Putting contests!

**LVC Fighters** - Started in late 2018, \$10 of each Jacquart Events stamped disc (only 150 stamped so far) goes to a LVC volunteer to help pay medical costs for various needs.

Sexton Firebird Support – In December & January, two 2020 Sexton Double Stamp/Innova Team Stamp, Glow Firebirds were auctioned off and \$450 was raised to help cover medical bills for someone abused by an ex-husband and another \$550 was donated to help cover a mother's funeral service.

Shade Tree - \$500 was donated to the Shade Tree (a women's and children shelter) from the 2020 event. 100% of the income from a Juliana Korver quilt, auctioned via the Innova Only Collectors Group, during this LVC will go to the shelter as well.

**St. Jude -** From 2016 through 2019, \$7,500 was donated to St. Jude via the LVC. In 2020, the LVC felt a more local connection with Team Carson and their LLS cause.

**Carson's Story** - Carson had been sick with strep throat and after two rounds of antibiotics, was taken to urgent care on May 15, 2016, to see why he wasn't recovering. After two blood draws, Carson went to St. Rose ER for 3 more draws. It's there where the family received the devastating news that Carson most likely had leukemia, with an initial white blood cell count of 400,000. Due to his dangerously high potassium levels, he was rushed to Sunrise Children's Hospital where he would have ports placed and begin dialysis immediately. On Monday May 16th, Carson was diagnosed with T-Cell AcuteLymphoblastic Leukemia. Carson was placed under anesthesia and would never wake up again. On May 18th, the Arreloa Family lost their 6 year old son, Carson.



Through their work with LLS, the family has found a way to honor Carson's memory by helping to raise money for blood cancer research.

Carson had a vibrant spirit and a heart of gold. He was outgoing, funny, smart, kind, artistic, fearless, and happy. He loved his stuffed Tiggers, dinosaurs, dancing, drawing, baseball, motorcycles, monster trucks, his little brother and sister, and his friends. He had a zest for life that was contagious and refreshing. It was impossible to be in a bad mood around him. They love and miss his big personality so much.

It is against the rules to either enter into private yards or to wade into the water to retrieve discs. Such action will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification and potential criminal/trespassing charges by the City of Henderson Police Department.

The LVC does not control when divers are permitted to retrieve discs. All discs retrieved from the diver are supposed to be given to the Tournament Director.

For discs recovered **BEFORE** the 2021 LVC -- all discs listing a phone number that starts with "702" are given to the Las Vegas Disc Golf Club while all others are retained through the 2021 LVC event until Sunday, February 23rd. Then, the unclaimed "2020 and prior" discs are donated to our Disc Golf in Schools program.

For discs collected **DURING** and **AFTER** the 2021 LVC -- all discs listing a phone number that starts with "702" are given to the Las Vegas Disc Golf Club while all others are retained until the 2022 LVC event.

During the LVC, all lost discs, separated by "Prior Years" and "This Year" can be found just outside the cart barn. If you find a disc during the 2021 event, please place it in the "This Year" lost & found bins.

Additionally, lost & found discs are not for sale and should only be taken by the owner of the disc (or their friend). Do not take a lost & found disc that is not yours unless you are grabbing it for a friend. Unmarked discs will be used as the TD sees fit.

There are several "levels" of PDGA- sanctioned events. Majors and NTs/Elites require that a rules proficiency (officials) exam has been passed by all players and Majors, NTs/Elites, and A-Tiers, require current PDGA membership to participate. For B and C-Tiers, a \$10 non-PDGA fee can be paid to play.

#### **Major Events**

Majors include World and National Professional and Amateur <u>championships</u>. Entry into these events are based on invitations and player qualification. Qualifications are awarded according to points acquired the prior year from PDGA events, and other criteria.

#### **National Tour / DGPT Elite Series**

NTs and DGPT Elite Series are <u>showcased Professional events</u> and limited to just Open and Open Women divisions (since 2016 for NTs). NT/Elites typically include three days of competition, with at least \$10,000 to \$15,000 added to the purse. Due to their popularity, "tiered" registration is required, allowing higher-rated Open and Open Women to register before others. The **LVC** was an NT from 2017 through 2019. Due to contractual differences with the PDGA, the LVC was not an NT in 2020. The DGPT Elite Series welcomed the LVC to their 2021 schedule and approved a waiver for use of three courses.



SuperTours are <u>regional events</u> that have a reliable and successful history. SuperTours require at least three rounds of play, at least \$3,000 added to the purse, 100+% payout to Pros, 110+% payout to Ams, and an Am player's package valued at \$25+. Current SuperTours number <u>over one hundred</u> per year. The **LVC** was a SuperTour from 2004 through 2016, and again in 2020. For 2017 through 2021, the Amateur and Aged-Protected Professional divisions were classified as an A-Tier.

#### **B-Tier**

B-Tiers are <u>State-level events</u> with at least two rounds of play, at least \$750 added to the purse, providing 100+% payout to Pro and Am fields, and an Am player's package valued at \$10+. The **LVC** was a B-Tier from 2001 through 2003.

#### **C-Tier**

C-Tiers are <u>local events</u> providing 85%+ payout to Pro and Am fields. The **LVC** was a C-Tier for its inaugural year (2000).

**X-Tier** 

X-Tier are unique/experimental events (doubles, ratings-based, team, etc.).


In May of last year, the PDGA Board of Directors approved changes for early registration exemptions. Per 1.02(C)(2)(a) of the Competition Manual, an unlimited number of players may register early based on their PDGA player rating. The first two tiers for LVC early registration are based on the Player Rating exemption.

Per 1.02(C)(3)(d), a limited number of players may register early based on an affiliated club membership, an event sponsorship, or volunteer services. Additionally, no more than one-third (33%) of the aged-professional spots, no more than one-third (33%) of the amateur spots, and no more than 50% of an offered division may be allocated for these early registrations. The 2021 LVC has a cap of 392 players (excluding the MPO & FPO divisions), 124 being aged-professional and 268 being amateur. Therefore, no more than 130 spots (41 aged-professional and 89 amateur) can be used by sponsors and/or volunteers for early registration. The next six tiers for LVC early registration are based on the Sponsor/Volunteer exemption.

The Open to All (final tier) registration date, November 27, 2020, was specifically selected to (1) avoid conflicts with other events that might have extra-curricular activities occurring on a Friday night, and (2) to make the date easily recognizable (Family Day, the day following the Thanksgiving holiday).

Note that the PDGA denied a waiver that would have allowed early registration man based on prior LVCs played (as done for recent LVC registrations) since this criteria was based on quantity of play, not quality of play.





Ever wonder where your entry money goes? In 2020, just under \$133,000 was collected in player entry fees (including the greens fees, PDGA tier fee, and an Ace Pool fee). But, "cash" costs to run the event totaled just over \$170,000. So...an additional \$37,000 in cash was needed from sponsors just to cover the bills.

The following breaks down event "cash" costs per player. "Basic" costs are those typically covered by player entries (your basic B and C Tier events). As larger sponsorships are acquired, event amenities can expand and becomes "Innova-Centric" (such as many A-Tier Events). Then, as sponsorships continue to grow, additional enhancements make the event "Innova-Opulent" (National Tours, DGPT Elite, and Majors)!

5. Some, but not all, participants like playing more than one course at an event. Detailed scoring analysis by each individual hole has found that Course Innova and Course Innova Factory Store are very difficult for all aged-protected divisions and all amateur divisions. Would you prefer to only play just one course over the entire event, specifically designed for the caliber of play for your tiering group?



6. The only way to accommodate more players is to (1) split up the event into two weekends or (2) add more courses that match those used at Wild Horse. The survey results from last year found that a majority did not want to split the event into two weekends. (It was also determined that staffing two events would likely be impossible.) The LVDGC is working with the City of Boulder City to install two disc golf courses on their municipal ball golf course. If the design matched those used at Wild Horse, five courses could be used for the 2021 LVC, which would allow the field to increase from 570 players to over 900. A downside to using five courses is that all participates would no longer be playing the exact same layouts. The MPO division would likely play the two hardest courses, all women divisions would likely play the two shortest courses, while all remaining divisions would play a mixture of three courses.

Would you support adding additional courses off-site, <u>if</u> they matched the design quality of Wild Horse, which would allow additional players to participate?


