



WELCOME FROM THE SPONSORS


Team LVC is continually amazed how the sponsorship support grows every year for the event. For 2023, over \$350,000 in direct cash, usable goods and food, sales and supplies, staffing and savings, or items borrowed was donated. Each sponsor is listed, by tier category, on pages **52, 54,** & **56**. Close to 100 individual sponsors are included! A majority is in goods (38%), about a quarter is in actual cash (23%), 15% is in media, 6% in cost savings, 5% in partnered sales, 4% in items borrowed (like baskets), 3% in credit, 2% in staff, 2% in supplies, and the remainder in other services.

Our Title sponsor, Innova Champion Discs, makes up 33% of all the sponsorship value. Our Lottery and Tour sponsors, Factory Store and DGPT, make up 29% of the value. Our two Course sponsors, Infinite Discs and Millennium, makes up 5% of the total value. The producer of the LVC, Jacquart Events LLC, totals 4% of the total value.

Over 30 vendors will be on-site at some time during the LVC. With the LVC being an Innova-centric event, only during the Saturday Fly Mart will you find competing manufacturer products. This year, we have added two options for DGPT tour card holders to also vend Saturday evening...at a much-reduced rate.

The **public release** of the **2023 LVC co-branded** Nate Sexton **Firebirds** and Calvin Heimburg **Toros** is **Saturday**, **February 25th**, **at 6 PM**. Lines started to form last year around 11 AM. Two lines will merge into one, with the first being Players and Platinum VIP Spectators (those who didn't attend the Player's Meeting), and then the second being all other badged individuals. The limit is 1 of each per person, while supplies last, and badges are required (and will be marked).

WELCOME FROM WILDHORSE

Once again, the Wildhorse Golf Course, established in 1958 and the only municipal golf course owned by the City of Henderson, is proud to host the 24th Annual Las Vegas Challenge disc golf tournament, presented by Innova Champion Discs. After the success of last seven events, improvements continue to be made to the two quasi-permanent disc golf courses on our property via Team LVC.

If you didn't know, disc golf play is available year-round at Wildhorse! Our 24-hole afternoon course, which incorporates four of the **Course Millennium** holes and most of the **Course Innova** holes, is available for play in the afternoon. Our 22-hole morning course, with tee times available from sunrise to half-an-hour after sunrise, incorporates many **Course Millennium** holes and **Course Infinite Discs** holes. When in town, please reserve a disc golf tee time by calling our Pro Shop at 702-434-9000 (Ext. 1).

Wildhorse is only one of three golf courses in the region recognized by Audubon International as an Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary – so please be careful of our wildlife and their protected habitat. Please note the local rules listed on pages **38** & **40**, some of which are extremely important to us.




PLAYER EXPERIENCE

Although most of the media attention is focused on the DGPT Elite Series divisions...as it should be since the Open divisions represent the top men and women players of our sport...we want ALL players of the LVC to feel like our event is like no other. We are lucky that the Wildhorse facility has enough acreage to accommodate three premier courses, which allows three different pools to participate in the LVC at the same time. This is why we ask that all sponsor and partner assets remain in place throughout the entire event so each player can get a sense of what the tour card holders are treated to throughout the year. This is why we host combined pool-player parties so everyone can appreciate the vibe and excitement that happens at premier events. This is why all players can have a caddie so their best friend, parent, sibling, or fan can also experience what it kind of means to be an "elite." In turn, we hope each player and their caddie respects each other, the volunteers, the vendors, and media representatives so a sense of professionalism is felt throughout the LVC.

We peaked our player allowances at the LVC back in 2017 (around 550 players). We just can't accommodate any more participants without using additional courses...and everyone only wants to play Wildhorse.



SPECTATOR EXPERIENCE

One of the key goals of Team LVC is to ensure that not only do the players and volunteers enjoy the event, but that spectators do as well! Ever since spectator passes have been required at DGPT Elite Series events in 2021, some hole redesigns have occurred to accommodate such. Additionally, using cart paths as natural assets for viewing simplifies separating spectator areas from the playing areas. The last two pages of this caddy book includes a large map depicting where spectators are permitted.

Spectator Rules & Policies are also provided on page 44.

With limited parking available at Wildhorse and prohibited on adjacent streets, an off-site parking area has been reserved, along with a shuttle service for spectators, A-Tier players, all caddies, and others. The remote parking area is located at the Whitney Ranch Rec. Center, 1575 Galleria Dr., Henderson, NV. Shuttle service is as follows:

Pre-Saturday (2/18) & Pre-Sunday (2/19): No shuttle service on Saturday, 2/18 or Sunday, 2/19. Parking is permitted at Wildhorse only during these first two practice days.

Monday: One (1) shuttle leaving the Rec. Center at the top of the hour starting at 6:00 AM and leaving Wildhorse at the bottom of the hour ending at 6:30 PM.

Tuesday & Wednesday: Two (2) shuttles leaving the Rec. Center at the top and bottom of the hour starting at 6:00 AM and leaving Wildhorse at the bottom and top of the hour ending at 6:30 PM on Tuesday and ending at 8:30 PM on Wednesday (to accommodate the 6 PM Player's Meeting – closed to all spectators except the Platinum VIPs).

Thursday & Friday: Three (3) shuttles leaving the Rec. Center every 20-minutes starting at 6:00 AM and leaving Wildhorse every 20-minutes starting at 6:20 AM and ending at 6:30 PM.

Major Changes

Competition Manual

1.05 PRACTICE ROUNDS, BEGINNING PLAY, LATE ARRIVALS - Adds language to reflect that more than two scorecards may be used, as well as clarifying penalties for players who do not provide their group with the opportunity to examine the scorecard.

G. The Tournament Director must provide <u>at least</u> two scorecards to each group, to be kept independently of one another. These scorecards may be of the same medium or of different media. The two scorecards must be reconciled by the group and submitted <u>Each member of the group should be given the opportunity to examine the scorecards and each member of the group must agree on an official scorecard and submit it by whichever method the Tournament Director has designated as the official scoring method for the tournament. Any player who denies the opportunity to another player in the group to examine and verify the official scorecard receives two penalty throws.</u>

1.06 GROUPING AND SECTIONING - Creates minimum standards for tee time posting. This simplified version grants TDs more leeway while also protecting players.

- L. At staggered start events with scheduled tee times. Tournament Directors must post tee times on the PDGA event page for all players in a given division no later than 40 12 hours prior to the first tee time for that division or one hour after the conclusion of play of the previous round for that division, whichever is later.
 - 1. If tee times must be adjusted after posting, no player may be assigned an earlier tee time without their affirmative consent.
 - Events with multiple tee time rounds in a single day must obtain a waiver of this rule from the PDGA Director of Event Support.
 - 3. The PDGA Mid-Event Weather Suspension Guidelines supersede this requirement where it is necessary for player safety or to complete rounds in progress.

Tour Standards

PASS-THROUGH FEES - Additional items added to pass-through fees, which must be specified in pre-registration materials.

Pass-through Fees are: PDGA Per-Player Fee, as required by Tier level; Greens Fees, meaning the fees required to secure the course(s) and permit play; Series Fees, meaning a fee paid by an event that is part of a points Series under CM 2.02.B toward Series-end prizes or payouts; Bathroom Fees, meaning the prorated per-player cost of toilet rental; and TD Fees, meaning a per-player amount not to exceed the PDGA Per-Player Fee for that Tier. All pass-through items and amounts must be published in pre-registration materials. Other event expenses, such as player packs and prizes, trophies, line paint, staff compensation, or lunch, are not included in pass-through fees.

Minor Changes

Officail Rules

803.01 MOVING OBSTACLES – Adds clarity to defining a casual obstacle, which is intended to be loose debris, not just any item that happens to be dead or detached.

B.1 A player may move casual obstacles that are on the playing surface where a supporting point may be placed when taking a stance. A casual obstacle is any item or collection of loose debris (such as stones, leaves, twigs, or unconnected branches), or any item as designated by the Director. Objects intentionally placed as part of the course or event are not casual obstacles.

PDGARULE UPDATES - PART III

Offical Rules (continued)

803.02 RELIEF FROM OBSTACLES - Changing it to say "by rule" allows for non-penalty relief in other rules to be allowable.

C. A player who takes relief other than as allowed above by rule receives one penalty throw.

804.01 MANDATORY ROUTES - Clarifies that mandatory routes restrict the path of the disc for the entire hole, regardless of the direction the disc is traveling and replaces "restricted space" with the clearer "restricted plane."

- A. A mandatory route restricts the path the disc may take to the target in the process of playing a hole.
- B. The restricted <u>space plane</u> is a vertical plane marked by one or more objects or other markers which define the edges of the space.
- C. If part of a thrown disc clearly enters into a restricted <u>space plane</u>, the player receives one penalty throw.
- D. If the thrown disc is released on the other side of the restricted **space plane** ...

806.03 CASUAL AREA – Clarifies that relief from casual areas are not penalized if taken in accordance to the rules.

- B. To obtain relief from a casual area, the player's lie may be relocated without penalty to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief (unless greater casual relief is announced by the Director).
- C. A player who takes relief other than as allowed by rule receives one penalty throw.

806.04.A: RELIEF AREA - Clarifies that Relief Areas are treated exactly the same as OB areas in all aspects except for the applied penalty throw. This includes discs landing within 1 meter of a relief area. This update also aids in how to handle situations where OB and Relief Areas share an edge.

A. A relief area is an area designated by the Director from which a disc may not be played, or any in-bounds area that players are prohibited by law from entering. A relief area is considered and played as an out-of-bounds area, but no penalty throw is applied with the exception that no penalty throw is assessed to a player whose disc comes to rest in a relief area.

813.01 ILLEGAL DISC - Provides additional clarity that players may not throw a disc that is intentionally deformed such that it no longer complies with the technical standards for approved discs.

- C. Other modifications to a disc after production make the disc illegal, including but not limited to: ...
 - Intentionally deforming a disc such that it is not in a circular, saucer-like configuration.

Competition Manual

- **3.04 DRESS CODE Clarifies that** players must wear a lower outer garment and allows any player to wear clothing that meet the requirements.
 - All competitors and staff are required to wear a shirt an upper garment and lower outer garment, such as a shirt and pants.
 - D.2. All players must wear <u>a shirt an upper garment</u> covering their upper chest area <u>and lower torso</u>. A well-tailored shirt with a collar and sleeves covering the upper arm shall be considered acceptable. Tank tops are not allowed for any competitor, but women may wear sleeveless shirts with collars. Women may also wear well-tailored one-piece tennis dresses with minimum one-inch-wide shoulder straps. A well-tailored shirt with a collar is acceptable, with or without sleeves. A well-tailored one-piece tennis dress with minimum one-inch-wide shoulder straps is also acceptable. Tank tops are not allowed for any competitor.




General - Contact Co-Tournament Director, **Scott Merritt**, at **702-370-0605** for any competition-related problems or questions, or Co-Tournament Director, **Jessica Jacquart**, at **702-275-9435** for any administration-related problems or questions. When in doubt, use the provisional rule (809.02).

Badges - Badges are required to be present while on the property and must be worn at all times unless actively playing/practicing.

Caddies - A caddie is a person who carries a player's equipment and/or assists the player during their round. Players may designate **one** caddie at a time during their round. A caddie must be at least 13 years of age and must comply with the same rules & requirements as their player. The Player is solely responsible for their caddie's conduct from the two-minute signal until the player's scorecard is submitted. Any penalties for misconduct by a caddie will be applied to both player and caddie. Caddies are **not part of the player group** for the purposes of making group calls or rulings (also see Player Group).

Cart Paths - The cart path is defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the concrete edge of the cart path (including raised edging) meet, unless otherwise marked by rope or paint. All other improvements (see examples below) adjacent to the cart path are not part of the cart path. The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on dirt or grass growing over a cart path edge is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)

Casual Water - Unless marked as O.B., play casual water as a Casual Area (806.03). Lie may be relocated to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief, without penalty.

Course Availability - Courses are closed after Wednesday evening. Players caught playing a closed course are in violation of Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Facility main gate is locked from sundown to sunrise.

Discs Retrieval (from Back Yards & Water Areas) - Entering into private yards or wading into water to retrieve a disc will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director and potential criminal/trespassing charges by the City of Henderson Police.

Dress Code (applies to All Divisions) - All players and their caddies are expected to dress appropriately and to maintain a clean and well-groomed appearance at all event sites and associated functions. (See Competition Manual, 3.04(D).)

Green – Unless marked by rope or paint, defined as the area within the <u>first</u> grass cut around a ball golf hole.

Island Holes - Disc must <u>come to rest</u> on marked islands (Course Innova, Holes 3, 6, and 7, and Course Infinite Discs, Holes 6 and 18). If island missed, <u>as approved by the PDGA</u>, take one-stroke penalty and next shot from the designated drop zone(s).

Media Rights - Disc Golf Pro Tour (Tour Series Sponsor), Jacquart Events LLC (Producer), and Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor) owns all media rights to the LVC. Any type of professional media equipment is <u>prohibited</u> without approval from the Disc Golf Pro Tour. Sharing LVC images, videos, and stories on personal social media



outlets via non-professional equipment such as cell phones are welcomed, as long as such personal posts are in no way monetized or promote a brand, business, product, or service. Spectators with cell phones or other non-professional portable devices are not considered media and are not granted media access. (Also see Page 42 & 44.)

Player Group – For all LVC divisions, the group consists of the players themselves, each player's individual caddie, any active Tournament staff such as leaderboard attendants, Tournament Officials, etc., and any credentialed media ONLY. No other people may be with the playing group. All others (including players who have already finished their round) are considered spectators and must remain in designated spectator areas.

Sand Traps - Sand traps are hazards (8.06.05). Take one-stroke penalty and play it where it lies (lie is not relocated). No relief provided from sand traps. Unless marked by rope or paint, defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the sand meet. The hazard line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The hazard line is part of the hazard area. (A disc landing on grass growing over a sand trap is in the hazard when 100% of the disc is on the hazard-side of the vertical plane.)

Selling of Merchandise - Permission is <u>not</u> granted to sell merchandise without consent of the Tournament Director. Such activities will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disgualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Smoking Areas - The designated smoking areas for all individuals present include parking lots, streets and service roads, outside balconies, and within 30 feet of any restroom or port-a-potty. Pace of play rules still apply. Any open and visual possession of any product banned under the smoking policy will be treated as a courtesy violation, and violators will be asked to put away the product until after the round has concluded.

Teeing Areas - The teeing area is defined by the area bounded by the edges of the provided tee pad (the artificial turf). When in use, Teeing Areas are in-bounds.

Two Meter Rule - Not in effect for all courses, all holes.

Water Areas – Unless marked by rope or paint, defined as the point where the water and the roots of the grass meet. The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on grass growing over water is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)

Zero Tolerance - Any inappropriate activities will be dealt with immediately.

The Disc Golf Network (DGN), official media and broadcasting platform of the DGPT, in conjunction with Jacquart Events LLC (Producer) and Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor), owns all media creation and broadcast rights. Any type of professional media equipment is prohibited without approval from the DGPT. All promotional & commercial media for print, radio, television, internet, and/or video publication must be approved by the DGPT. Promotional & commercial media includes any use of LVC material monetized or which promotes a brand, business, product, or service. Approved media will be supplied credentials to be worn at all times while at the facility. Spectators and competitors with cell phones are not considered media and are not granted media access.

Spectators and competitors using cell phones to share LVC images, videos, and stories on personal social media outlets via cell phones is welcomed, as long as such personal posts are in no way monetized or promote a brand, business, product, or service.

The DGPT defines Player-centric Media as media filmed by players or their support teams for the sole use in promoting their brand. Videos should <u>not</u> be used to promote brands that are direct competitors of an event or DGPT sponsor. Player based media is allowed at Pro Tour events as long as the filming does not interfere with any other filming and proper credit is given to the event. In this instance, proper credit includes mentioning the event in its full name – including title and presenting sponsor and including that the event is a Disc Golf Pro Tour stop. This includes all filming during the week prior to the event.

Failure to follow these requests will result in these privileges being revoked on a player-by-player basis.


