


Parking Options & Limits


An on-site parking pass will be provided for all Registered Players, Full-Time Volunteers, Vendors, Media Partners, Platinum VIP Spectators, Full-Event Spectators, and Special Guests.

The **Driving Range** (Green Parking Pass – Entire Event) is reserved for Players, Media, Vendors, Volunteers, & Overflow needs. Please be careful driving from the back of the Clubhouse to the driving range, which takes you through Tournament Central. (Note that driving nets are used for driving practice versus the range. If this is unacceptable, the Sunset Park disc golf course is less than 3 miles due west on Warm Springs).

The **Parking Lot** (Black Parking Pass – Entire Event, Yellow Parking Pass – Thursday Only, Orange Parking Pass – Friday Only, Pink Parking Pass – Saturday Only, & Purple Parking Pass – Sunday Only) is reserved for Platinum VIP Spectators, Full-Event Spectators, Daily Passes, and Special Guests. Limited quantities of daily parking passes are available at \$20 per day.

Caddies and spectators who do not purchase the limited Platinum VIP or Full-Event Spectator Pass (which includes an on-site parking pass) must carpool with someone who has a parking pass, use Uber/Lyft-like transportation options (pick-up and drop-off area provided), or purchase a daily parking pass (limited quantities available at \$20 per day). Street parking is not permitted, and vehicles parked on the street will likely be towed immediately by the City of Henderson.









Emergency Contacts - For emergency situations, please contact the Tournament Director (Jeff Jacquart at 702-249-0387), the Competition Director (Scott Merritt at 702-370-0605), or the Events Director (Jessica Jacquart at 702-275-9435) for any situations that cannot be addressed using the PDGA's provisional rule (see OR 809.02).

Awards & Distribution of Prizes - Awards will be done immediately after each division's scores are verified, near Innova Basket 18 (the Trophy Tent). All 1st Place sudden death play-offs for divisions playing **Course Innova** will be Holes 1, 3, & 18; for divisions playing **Course Millennium** will be Holes 15, 16, 17, & 18; for divisions playing **Course Infinite** will be Holes 16, 17, & 18. Ties for 2nd & 3rd Place trophies will be based on final hot round. The LVC is a "**True Amateur/Trophy-Only**" event (no merchandise payout and the amateur payback value far exceeds 125% of the net entry, with over a 500% payback). PayPal is used for Professional cash prizes (via F&F) and will be distributed within **two business days** of the completion of the event (as required by CM 1.10.G.3). A W-9 is required for all payments of \$600 or more and may delay payment if not provided.

Badges - Badges are <u>not</u> required to be present while on the property, but players must carry them when practicing and display to tournament staff, when requested. Badges are also required to access Lines #1 & #2 for the LVC co-branded Nate Sexton Firebird & Calvin Heimburg Toro sales. Firebird Line #3 is for all non-badged sales.

Barbed Wire - Unlike popular belief, there is <u>no</u> automatic relief from barbed wire. (So, unless specifically stated by the TD, it is <u>neither</u> 1 meter <u>nor</u> 2 meters!) The only barbed wire found at Wildhorse is locate on top of 6 foot walls and/or fences. Since the walls and fencing are O.B., 1 meter relief is provided from these barbed wire situations.

Benefit of the Doubt – Unlike popular belief, the phrase "benefit of the doubt" is not within the PDGA rules. Making a ruling based on what benefits the thrower <u>only</u> comes into play <u>after</u> all members of the group has made their best efforts at determining the ruling. This determination <u>must</u> be made without any regard as to whether or not the decision is beneficial to the player. **Only if the group cannot come to a majority decision (aka, a tied vote) should a ruling be based on what is most beneficial to the player.**

Caddies - A caddie is a person who carries a player's equipment and/or assists the player during their round. Players may designate one caddie at a time during their round and **they must wear the provided caddie vest**. A caddie must be at least 13 years of age and must comply with the same rules & requirements as their player, including the dress code. The Player is solely responsible for their caddie's conduct from the two-minute signal until the player's scorecard is submitted. Any penalties for misconduct by a caddie will be applied to both player and caddie. Caddies are not part of the player group for the purposes of making group calls or rulings (also see Player Group). A PDGA waiver has been approved to enforce CM 4.03 at the LVC.

Cart Paths (defining O.B.) - The cart path is defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the concrete edge of the cart path (including raised edging) meet, unless otherwise marked by rope or paint. All other improvements (see examples below) adjacent to the cart path are not part of the cart path. The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on dirt or grass growing over a cart path edge is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)



Casual Water - By default, any body of water that is in-bounds and has not been explicitly declared O.B. is a Casual Area (see OR 806.03). When in a Casual Area, a lie may be relocated to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief, without penalty.

Check-In (for Event) - All players are required to check-in for the event at least two hours before your Thursday tee time. Event Check-In is located within the Banquet Room. Any player who does not check in shall forfeit their official place and entry fee (see CM 1.04.C).

Check-In (before Tee Time) - All players must check in with their Course Starter no less than 5 minutes prior to their tee time <u>each day</u> and <u>be</u> <u>present at the starting hole</u> for the **5 minutes preceding their tee time**. Players who do not check in with the starter by this time or who are not present at the starting hole for the 5 minutes preceding their tee time **receive a two-throw penalty** (see CM 1.04.E). If a player is not present at the start of the round for their assigned group, the player is considered absent, does not play the hole, and receives a score of par plus four (see OR 811.F.4).





Course Availability & Practice Play – The Wildhorse Courses are closed after Wednesday evening. Players caught playing a closed course are in violation of Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director. The historic disc golf course at Sunset Park is less than 3 miles due west of Wildhorse, down Warm Springs and right on Eastern. The Wildhorse facility's main gate is locked from sundown to sunrise.

Discs Retrieval from Back Yards & Water Areas - Entering into private yards or wading into water to retrieve a disc will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director and potential criminal/trespassing charges by the City of Henderson Police.

Dress Code (applies to All Divisions & Caddies) - All players and their assigned caddie are expected to dress appropriately and to maintain a clean and well-groomed appearance. CM 4.04 is being enforced for players and caddies (we are treating the event like a Major, something missing west of the Colorado Rockies) and a waiver is not necessary from the PDGA since Wildhorse is a private facility. At a minimum, the outermost upper garment cannot be a tank-top or t-shirt. Shirts that hang down lower than the bottom hemline on the player's lower garment shall be tucked in. No ripped shirts, shorts, or pants are allowed, including unhemmed garments, or garments with torn or cut "vents" at the shirt collar. No offensive, profane, or obscene slogans or logos are allowed on clothing.

Greens (defining O.B.) - Unless marked by rope or paint, defined as the area within the first grass cut around a ball golf hole.

Island Holes (defining O.B.) - Disc must come to rest on marked islands (Course Innova, Holes 3, 6, and 7A, and Course Infinite Discs, Holes 7 and 18). If island missed, with a waiver approved by the PDGA, take one-stroke penalty and player <u>must</u> take next shot from the designated drop zone(s).

Media Rights - Jacquart Events LLC (Producer) and Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor) owns all media rights to the LVC. Any type of professional media equipment is prohibited without approval from the Producer and Title Sponsor. Sharing LVC images, videos, and stories on personal social media outlets via non-professional equipment such as cell phones are welcomed, as long as such personal posts are in no way monetized or promote a brand, business, product, or service.

Player Group - For all LVC divisions, the group consists of the players themselves, each player's individual caddie, any active Tournament staff such as leaderboard attendants, Tournament Officials, etc., and any credentialed media only. No other individuals may be with the playing group. All others (including players who have already finished their round) are considered spectators and must remain in designated spectator areas. A PDGA waiver has been approved to enforce CM 4.03 at the LVC.

Rule of Verticality - Unlike popular belief, the phrase "rule of verticality" is not within the PDGA rules. The out-of-bounds line extends a vertical plane. If your <u>entire</u> disc is beyond this vertical plane, including being above the surface/playing area, then it is out-of-bounds.

Sand Traps - Sand traps are hazards (see OR 8.06.05). Take one-stroke penalty and play it where it lies (lie is not relocated). No relief provided from sand traps. Unless marked by rope or paint, defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the sand meet. The hazard line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The hazard line is part of the hazard area. (A disc landing on grass growing over a sand trap is in the hazard when 100% of the disc is on the hazard-side of the vertical plane.)

Scoring - Each player must keep an independent scorecard recording scores after each hole for the entire group. A player who refuses to keep score will be disqualified. Players may delegate scorekeeping duties only to their designated caddie. (see CM 808.) When the round is completed, <u>as a group</u>, verify scores at the Scoring / Millennium tent (located in the Throw & Flow Garden). A "group" submission is needed to address any provisionals, questions, or concerns a player or the group may have <u>as a whole</u>. It is easier to address such concerns with everyone present.

Selling of Merchandise - Permission is not granted to sell merchandise without consent of the Tournament Director. Such activities will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Smoking Areas - The designated smoking areas for all individuals present include parking lots, streets and service roads, outside balconies, and within 30 feet of any restroom or port-a-potty. Pace of play rules still apply. Any open and visual possession of any product banned under the smoking policy will be treated as a courtesy violation, and violators will be asked to put away the product until after the round has concluded. A PDGA waiver has been approved to enforce CM 4.04 at the LVC.


Speed of Play - All competitors shall play without undue delay and make every effort to keep up with the group in front of them. Undue delay means delays in play, other than as permitted by rule, that affect the pace of play of the group behind them. (See CM 3.02.) The rules permit you to check for wind, use rangefinders, change discs, discuss options with your caddie, etc. – but all <u>must</u> be done within your allowed 30 seconds. The 30 seconds starts when a reasonable amount of time is given to arrive at and determine the lie, and the playing area remains clear. (See OR 802.03.) Loud or annoying noises <u>do not</u> reset the 30-second clock. A player causing undue delays should be issued an excessive time violation. Players are expected to call a violation when one has clearly occurred. A call must be made promptly to be enforceable. If a group as a whole causes undue delay or refuses to enforce rules is a courtesy violation and may be issued a tournament warning for overt failure or refusal to enforce rules.

Teeing Areas - The teeing area is defined by the area bounded by the edges of the provided tee pad (the artificial turf). When in use, Teeing Areas are in-bounds.

Two Meter Rule - Not in effect for all courses, all holes.

Water Areas – Unless marked by rope or paint, defined as the point where the water and the roots of the grass meet. The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on grass growing over water is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)

Zero Tolerance - Any inappropriate activities will be dealt with immediately.

Aces - \$100 Each (Contest for Players)

All official Tournament Aces (no longer the longest, per day, per course) are worth **\$100** and the player receives a **LVDGC Ace disc** too! Everyone in at no extra cost. Over the last five years, we had 5 Aces hit in 2024, 1 Ace in 2023, 2 Aces in 2022, 4 Aces in 2021, and 3 Aces in 2020. **Total prize estimated around \$500**!

Ace Pool - Super Pot / \$5 Buy-In (Contest for Players))



The \$5 Super Ace Pool is split between those that paid into the Super Ace Pot, and the player receives a LVDGC Ace disc! Over the last five years, we had 3 of the 5 Aces hit in 2024 be "Super" (worth \$1,625), 0 of the 1 Ace hit in 2023 be "Super" (worth \$1,2290), 0 of the 2 Aces hit in 2022 be "Super" (worth \$1,790), 2 of the 4 Aces in 2021 be "Super" (worth \$1,700), and 2 of the 3 Aces hit in 2020 be "Super" (worth \$1,810). **Total prize estimated around \$1,500!** Don't miss out on this gamble!

Hole No. 6 on Course Innova, Hole No. 17 on Course Millennium, and Hole No. 1 on Course Infinite. Drive must land inbounds to qualify. (Sand traps are not considered in-bounds for this contest since you incur a penalty.) Winners win a Millennium disc, an Infinite disc, & a LVDGC CTP disc. Total prize value around \$180 (\$60 per course)!
